EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. For each exhibit entered, an official NSW CFA entry form must be completed and a copy of the exhibit's pedigree must be submitted and forwarded with the Summary Sheet that accompanies this Schedule.
2. All exhibits will be automatically entered into 3 (three) rings unless your entry form has been marked indicating which ring / rings you wish to enter.
3. There will be no reduction in fees if you enter only one ring. The exception to this is as follows:
 - a. A Judge may enter an exhibit/exhibits into any ring they are not assigned to judge.
 - b. An exhibitor who has purchased a kitten from a judge and has owned a kitten for a period of not more than 3 (three) months may enter that exhibit into a ring not assigned to the judge from whom they purchased the exhibit.
4. All prizes, trophies, product and cards once placed on cages/or issued will become the responsibility of the exhibitor and cannot be replaced if lost.
5. The Show Entry Clerk reserves the right to transfer entries that are not correctly entered.
6. It is a condition of entry that all exhibits shall remain in the hall until the close of Show at 5 P.M Saturday/4 P.M Sunday - Unless a valid request is made in writing to the Show Secretary not less than 14 days prior to the show date.
7. The Show Committee reserves the right to alter judging assignments should the need arise
8. A Judge or Steward does not have to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench exhibits with a reported history of fractious behaviour. Show Managers and Show Committee in consultation with the Show Representative, have the right to require the removal of the latter exhibits from the Show.
9. To be eligible for showing, a Companion Cat must be desexed. Companion Kitten exhibits over the age of 6 months must be desexed. For an unregistered Companion Exhibit, a copy of the exhibit's certification of sterilisation (desexing) signed by a qualified Veterinary Surgeon must accompany the entry.

EXHIBITOR MEMBERSHIP STATUS

An exhibitor in NSW must be a current financial member of the NSW Cat Fancier's Association Inc, CATSNSW or ANCATS. New exhibitors will be permitted to show 3 (three) times as a non member provided their exhibits satisfy the requirements of Show Procedure 5.3 and are registered with NSW CFA..

An exhibitor not resident in NSW must be a financial member of a recognised Governing Body or ANCATS and the exhibits must satisfy the requirements of Show Procedure 5.4

PLEASE NOTE: VETERINARY INSPECTION

All exhibitors are required to handle their own exhibits at the Vetting Table All Carry baskets are to be placed on the Veterinary Inspection Table, in full view of the Veterinary Officer and Steward, the Veterinary Steward is to assist with the control of litter kittens after Veterinary Inspection until all kittens have been inspected.

An exhibitor must produce to the Veterinary Officer, documentary evidence of vaccination (not less than 14 days prior) for all kitten exhibits to be shown on that day. This must be an original certificate issued by a qualified veterinary practitioner, or a photocopy of the complete certificate. The certificate must clearly identify the kitten – registered name, breed, and sex. failure to produce this vaccination evidence at vetting may result the rejection of the kitten in question from that show as per Show Procedure 6.3 c).

Any exhibit found to be showing signs of any disease etc. will be barred from competing and immediately removed from the Show area to a special quarantine area or be required to be taken home. The Veterinary Officer's decision in this respect will be final.

BOTH FRONT AND BACK CLAWS OF ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE CLIPPED.

****** NSW CFA Inc. Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Awards ******

A cat/kitten may accumulate points for a Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Award only whilst it is in the ownership of a financial member of the NSW Cat Fancier's Association Inc.

Note that:

- (i) Should an owner become a member of the Association after the commencement of the calendar year i.e after 1st January, a cat/kitten owned by the new member will be eligible for the awards but points will only accumulate the date that the membership application is processed by the Association Office.
- (ii) If during the year the ownership of a cat/kitten is transferred from a financial member to a new owner, who is not a member, the cat/kitten's ownership by a financial will be deemed to be continuous provided a membership application from the new owner is received by the Association's Office within 4weeks (28 days) of the transfer as recorded by the NSW CFA Inc.

Joint owners must each be financial members of the Association.
