ENTRY GUIDELINES

It's easier than you think to prepare for and enter these great awards.

Importantly, they are to encourage and reward our youth for their interest in rural and country life and for their interest in the Royal Bathurst Show and the Show movement generally.

Entry is easy.

Young Country Achievers - You need to

- prepare a *résumé* focussing on your achievements
- write a short letter indicating why you'd like to be a **Young Country Achiever**
- include a recent *photograph* of yourself
- list several *referees* and testimonials
- **participate** in activities at the **Royal Bathurst Show** – perhaps as a Junior Steward in one or more areas of the show, or as an exhibitor & participant in different events & competitions
- attend a short *interview* prior to the Show with a small panel of judges who want to meet you and hear about the contributions you are making

Literature Awards: To enter you have to

- **write** and submit a *short story* of 500 to 1,000 words demonstrating your knowledge of agriculture, horticulture, the environment, rural or local issues.
- **participate** in activities at the **Royal Bathurst Show** – perhaps as a Junior Steward in one or more areas of the show, or as an exhibitor & participant in different events & competitions
